An example of an unsaturated solution is a teaspoon of sugar in a glass of water. If one adds a teaspoon of sugar to a glass of water, it dissolves, and one can still add more sugar to it because it is still unsaturated. However, at some point, the sugar no longer dissolves in the water because the substance is saturated.

What Are Examples of Unsaturated Solutions?
